Business arising from last meeting:

Student Success Plan:

Literacy Goal: We will improve achievement in literacy for each of our students, with a specific focus on our students of African and/or Mi'kmaw/Indigenous ancestry.

- To intentionally and explicitly teach reading and writing genres through mini lessons during Readers' and Writers' Workshop
- P-3: incorporate decodable books into instruction

Students will...

- Demonstrate comprehension strategies during read alouds and independent reading
- Identify writing genres and develop proficiency with using different genres in their own writing
- Quick write practice

Staff will...

- Become more familiar with writing genres to be explicitly taught per grade level and create a school wide continuum (refer to Literacy Continuum resource Fountas and Pinnell, seek out guest authors)
- Intentionally choose mentor texts when planning mini lessons (can utilize Teacher Resources in Library)

Mathematics Goal: We will improve achievement in mathematics for each of our students, with a specific focus on our students of African and/or Mi'kmaw/Indigenous ancestry.

• Be intentional about how to gather evidence of learning for fact fluency and use this evidence for planning

Students will...

- Students will demonstrate improved accuracy, flexibility and efficiency with facts
- Students will be open to greater risk taking and be more comfortable with sharing thinking (gather data through ongoing classroom observation/assessment, student focus group)

Staff will...

- Use progression charts to plan lessons and target small groups in fluency/number sense
- Use HRCE assessment templates and math running records to plan for instruction (4-6, P-3 begin to explore)
- Use Criteria for Determining Level of Success for Computational Fluency to determine next steps for individual students

Well-being Goal: We will improve well-being at our school for each of our students, with a specific focus on our students of African and/or Mi'kmaw/Indigenous ancestry.

• Explore 'notion of fairness' which is an aspect of deep culture

Students will...

- Recognize that others may not feel the same as they do re: fairness
- Resolve conflict more peacefully

Staff will...

- Provide orientation to student leaders to acknowledge different underlying beliefs about fairness
- Provide opportunities for students to dialogue about what fairness could mean to them and others
