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DETERMINING PRIORITIES

How the school engaged with students, teachers, the School Advisory Council (SAC), and other partners within the school community, to determine how to use grant funds:

[We formed a Well-Being committee to brainstorm ways to increase student well-being and sense of belonging. The PE teacher took a lead role in mentoring teachers as they explored ways to get their students outside for physical activity. Teachers implemented activities that promoted movement and nature, while ensuring curriculum outcomes were met.
