**Student Success Plan:**

**Literacy Goal:** We will improve student achievement in literacy.

Strategies:

- Teachers will create flexible groupings in the reading workshop.
- Teachers will use reading workshop daily with a focus on explicit small group instruction to students.
- Teachers will provide daily mini-lessons with a clear learning goal for students.

**Math Goal:** We will improve student achievement in mathematics.

Strategies:

- Teachers will use ongoing formative assessment (conversations, observations, products) to develop flexible groupings for targeted small group math instruction.
- Teachers will co-construct problem solving criteria with students, teaching them to self-assess in relation to this criteria.

**Well-Being Goal:** We will improve students' well-being.

Strategies:

- Staff will empower students' voice and choice by facilitating opportunities for students to learn through their own cultures, interests and passions
- Staff will provide tools in the classroom to promote mindfulness (mindfulness routines, outdoor classroom)
