Primary and One teachers have observed increased engagement and achievement during writing activities. Students have demonstrated increased stamina, confidence and risk-taking during encoding, directly applying skills practiced during systematic and explicit phonics instruction.

We are committed as a School Advisory Committee (SAC) to work with staff and families to support student success in areas of literacy, math and wellbeing with a specific focus on our students of African and/or Mi'kmaw/Indigenous ancestry. We conducted a family survey to hear from families about ways we can continue to know *each* of our students in ways that affirm, validate, nurture, honour and respect. As a School Advisory Council, we are also committed to exploring ways we can further support our newcomer families. We are working toward follow up actions that reflect what we have learned though this process.

Main themes from the family survey were summarized and discussed at a SAC meeting - key actions to be implemented 2024/25.

Two additional community members were recruited - 1 will start in June 2024 and the other in Sept 2024.
